TIN CONTROL ORDINANCE, 1954  
TIN CONTROL REGULATIONS

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Tin Control Ordinance, 1954, the Yang di-Pertuan Agong hereby makes the following regulations: 41 of 1954.

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Tin Control (Amendment) Regulations, 1958.** Citation.

2. Paragraph (2) of regulation 43 of the Tin Control Regulations, 1955, is hereby amended by substituting a colon for the full-stop at the end thereof and inserting immediately thereafter the words: Amend-

“Provided that no Certificate of Production shall be issued under this paragraph in respect of any producing unit which was not in operation at any time during the quota period immediately preceding the quota period referred to unless the Central Committee in its discretion consents to such issue.”.

IN exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph (1) of regulation 4 of the Tin Control (Buffer Stock) Regulations, 1956, the Minister of Natural Resources hereby fixes the period of one calendar month from the 1st day of October, 1958, to the 31st day of October, 1958, inclusive as the ninth contribution period for the purposes of Part II of the said Regulations and declares that the rate of contribution shall be \$21 (Twenty-one dollars) per picul of tin concentrates during such contribution period. ORDER UNDER ARTICLE 162

IN exercise of the powers conferred by Article 162 of the Federal Constitution and after consultation with the Governments of the States, the Yang di-Pertuan Agong hereby makes the following order:

Citation.

1. This order may be cited as the **Federal Constitution (Modification of Laws) (State Nationality Enactments) Order, 1958**.

2. The modifications specified in the third column of the Schedule, being modifications which appear to the Yang di-Pertuan Agong necessary or expedient for the purpose of bringing the Enactments specified in the first column of the Schedule into accord with the provisions of the Constitution, shall be made in the provisions of the said Enactments specified in the second column of the said Schedule.

## "SCHEDULE

[Sections 5 (2) and (3) and (5)]

I, .....of.....hereby declare on oath that I absolutely and entirely renounce and adjure all loyalty to any country or State outside the Federation, and I do swear that I will be faithful and bear true allegiance to His Highness the Sultan of Johore and His successors according to law and will give due obedience to all lawfully constituted authorities in the Federation.\*

[\* To such Oath shall be added such words as will, according to his religious beliefs, bind the conscience of the person taking the Oath].

## ELECTRICITY ORDINANCE, 1949

CENTRAL ELECTRICITY BOARD PENSIONS (AMENDMENT)  
REGULATIONS, 1958

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 4 of the Central Electricity Board Pensions Scheme, 1957, the Central Electricity Board with the approval of the Yang di-Pertuan Agong has made the following regulations:

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Central Electricity Board Pensions (Amendment) Regulations, 1958**, and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 31st day of August, 1957.

2. Paragraph 1 of Regulation 7 of the Central Electricity Board Pension Regulations, 1957, is hereby amended by deleting the proviso thereto and substituting therefor the following new proviso:

"Provided that:

(a) in the case of an officer retiring under the provisions of section 28A of the Scheme, in calculating the gratuity referred to in this paragraph there shall be substituted for the multiplying factor of twelve and a half the factor set out in Column 2 of the Schedule hereto appropriate to the age of an officer on his birthday last preceding the date of his retirement as set out in the corresponding part of Column 1 of the said Schedule;

(b) any officer retiring under the provisions of section 28A of the Scheme and to whom a pension is payable under the provisions of this Scheme may if such pension does not exceed \$3,000 *per annum* be granted in lieu of such pension a gratuity equal to the amount of such pension multiplied by the factor set out in Column 2 of the Schedule hereto appropriate to the age of the officer on his birthday last preceding the date of his retirement as set out in the corresponding part of Column 1 of the said Schedule."
