## MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE (EXTENDED APPLICATION) (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1967

An Act to amend the Municipal Ordinance (Extended Application) Ordinance, 1948.

[30th September, 1967.]

WHEREAS it is desired to amend the Municipal Ordinance (Extended Application) Ordinance, 1948, which provides for the Ruler-in-Council in creating any Municipality to apply and extend to such Municipality any of the provisions of the Municipal Ordinance in force in the States of Malacca and Penang: F.M. 3 of 1948.

WHEREAS it is expedient for the purpose only of ensuring uniformity of law and policy to make a law with respect to local government:

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of Clause (4) of Article 76 of the Constitution BE IT ENACTED by the Duli Yang Maha Mulia Seri Paduka Baginda Yang di-Pertuan Agong with the advice and consent of the Dewan Negara and Dewan Ra'ayat in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Municipal Ordinance (Extended Application) (Amendment) Act, 1967. Short title.
2. Sub-sections (3) and (4) of section 3 of the Municipal Ordinance (Extended Application) Ordinance, 1948, are hereby amended as follows: Amendment of section 3.  
F.M. 3 of 1948.
  - (a) for the words "House of Representatives" substitute "State Legislative Assembly"; and
  - (b) for the words "said House" substitute "said Assembly".
